#### Green Guide Pilot Project Breakdown

The Average Construction and Operations Credits in the chart refer only to credits that Pilots are confident they will achieve. Most Pilot projects attempt to achieve many more credits than are listed below.

#### Update on the Green Guide Pilot Program

The Pilot program continues to grow rapidly. 79 projects are currently registered, representing 22,000,000 square feet. The majority of Pilots are pursuing the Construction Section and fully half are pursuing the Operations section, as well. The majority of Green Guide Pilot projects are new construction acute care facilities. However, a growing number of Pilots are additions, renovations, or a combination of the two. Additionally, the Green Guide has proved to be a flexible tool for all project sizes, from 2,000 sf to 3,000,000 sf.
